Que: Can Shareholder claim unpaid/unclaimed Dividend?

Ans: Yes, Shareholder can claim Dividend for last 7 Financial Years from Company. The Shareholder shall make written application to the Company for such claims.

Que: Can a Shareholder claim unpaid/unclaimed Dividend declared for the period of preceding 7 Financial Years? If Yes, how?

Ans: Yes, the Shareholder is required to make application to “Investor’s Education and Protection Fund Authority” to claim the Dividend declared for the period preceding 7 Financial Years in **Form IEPF-5** (Link of Form IEPF-5: <http://www.iepf.gov.in/IEPFA/refund.html>).
